**ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE DECLARATION OF INTENT BY THE CITY OF
ZACHARY TO HAVE THE CERTAIN MOVABLE PROPERTY DECLARED TO BE SURPLUS
AND ALLOWING FOR THE DISPOSAL OF SAME**

WHEREAS, the City of Zachary (the "City") owns certain movable property no longer of use to the City, in which it reasonably believes the cost of removal, repair and/or required maintenance of the same will exceed the value and usefulness to the City, it is the intention of the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Zachary to declare the property described as:

- to be surplus property of the City, and to wit:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council for the City of Zachary that the referenced property be considered to be surplus property of the City, and as such after any and all notice, hearing and legal delay be disposed of or sold at public auction.

This Ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of ten (10) calendar days after publication by the City Council for the City of Zachary unless the referenced ordinance shall specify another effective date, all pursuant to § 2-10 (C) of the Home Rule Charter adopted by the electors for the City of Zachary.
